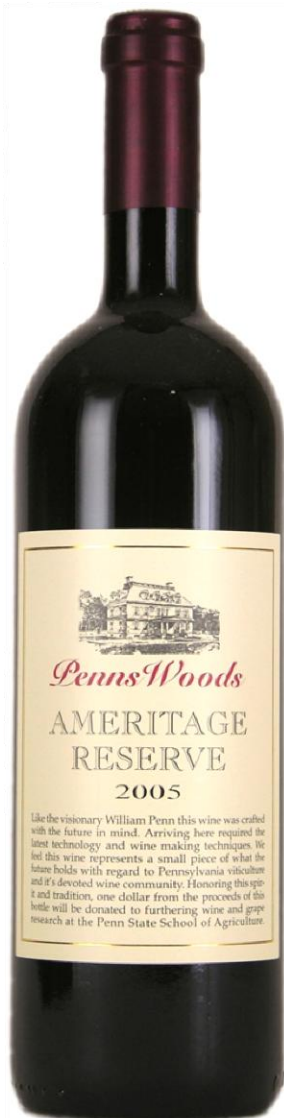

Ameritage Reserve

“The best of the best” is a phrase often heard, but in the case of the Ameritage Reserve, it is simply a statement of fact. Winemaker Gino Razzi, after inspecting, tasting and re-tasting every barrel of Ameritage, selects those few that truly show unique and special qualities.

The 2005 Ameritage Reserve is a blend of many grapes – cabernet sauvignon, cabernet franc, petite verdot, merlot, sangiovese.

Rested for 2 years in French oak *barrisques*.

A complex nose full of dark cherries, semi-sweet chocolate and subdued spice explodes onto the palate in the form of enormous red fruit, a hint of tobacco and soft tannins. A complex bordeaux blend redefining what people think about not just east coast wines, but American wines in general.

Pairs with bold meat dishes like venison or steak.
