Tasting Notes: This wine gives off tart red berry notes on the nose that follow through onto the palate. Flavors of smoke and tobacco are highlighted at the finish with robust, dusty tannins that complement the silky body of this wine.

Aging Process:

- French Oak for 20 months
- 14% ABV

- Rows 47-52
- Year(s) Planted: Planted in the early 80's and additional vines inter-planted in 2011
- Age of Vines: 6-35 years
- Soil Type: Clay and 1-10 inch rocks, very iron rich
- Pruning Style: Double guyot and cordon spur
- Tonnage per Acre: Produces approx. 3.5 tons per acre
- Typical Harvest: After second week of October
